

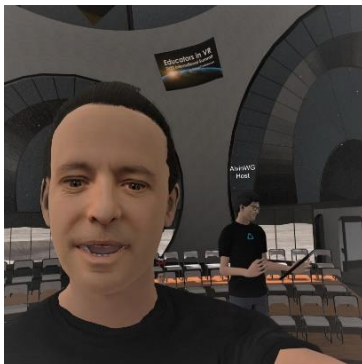


# Educators in VR

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## Daniel Dyboski-Bryant Co-Founder, Educators in VR

Daniel Dyboski-Bryant co-founded Educators in VR with Lorelle VanFossen in 2018, bringing together educators, learners, researchers, and passionate enthusiasts to work together to integrate immersive technology into education. In the past year, they've produced over 300 events in VR, hosting classes, trainings, workshops, and meetups in AltspaceVR, ENGAGE, and other VR platforms. They produced the 2020 Educators in VR International Summit over six 24-hr days across six VR platforms for more than 6,000 event attendees, Students in VR conference in May, and the 2020 iLRN Conference for the Immersive Learning Research Network in June. This fall, they'll produce a 2-day student take-over of the United Nations.



Educators in VR offers consulting, production, and extensive training programs for educational and business VR events on multiple platforms. They are partners with iLRN and the Virtual World Society, working together to evangelize the XR technologies in education.

Daniel Dyboski-Bryant was honored with the 2019 INSPIRE Award for Best Tutor in Wales – Adult Community Learning, and is a lifelong educator from a family of educators and speaks 5 languages. He is a trainer, speaker and consultant of VR in education with clients including schools, colleges, universities, design teams, training companies, councils and private individuals.

Daniel hosts educational events in AltspaceVR and ENGAGE VR regularly, bringing together educators, industry experts, and cutting edge developers to share and learn from each other and keep up with the latest XR technology.

In his daytime job Daniel is the Project Lead for Exploring VR in Further Education, Remote Learning and Language, ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) Lecturer, and Trainer at Coleg Llandrillo, Grwp Llandrillo-Menaia in North Wales UK.
